Conspicuity Markings

The Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for Transport has issued a statement regarding the introduction of the Conspicuity Marking legislation.

Due to the current economic climate, the Department for Transport has decided to delay the introduction until 10 July 2011. Until this date, existing requirements within the Road Vehicle Lighting Regulations will apply.

New regulations will be drafted to incorporate this change and will be issued as soon as possible.

However, applications for Whole Vehicle Type Approvals for vehicles of categories N2, N3, O3 & O4 , for ECWVTA, NSSTA and IVA must include conformance with Directive 2007/35/EC, with technical requirements to ECE Regulation 48.03, in line with the Framework Directive 2007/46/EC.
